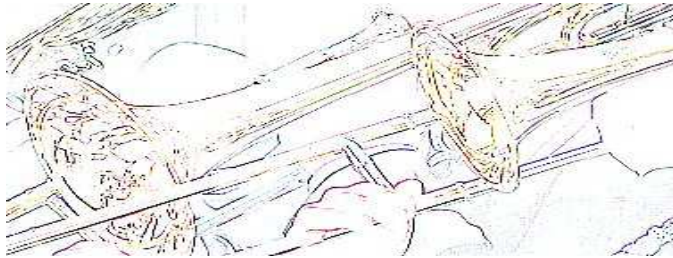

- **Copenhagen Brass** is a relatively new ensemble. Active since 1999 and established as an association since 2004.
- **The members** are 12 brassplayers and percussion. Copenhagen Brass consists of four trumpets, a flugelhorn, two French horns, three trombones, a euphonium, a tuba and percussion. The members are qualified musicians from the Danish conservatories and skilled amateurs.
- **The repertoire** spans a long period in time, consisting of music from the renaissance, the romantic period as well as contemporary music. We also have play jazz and entertainment music, and is therefore not shy of any genres.



Activities

The last couple of years we have held regular concerts in churches in Copenhagen.

We have also had short trips to Hamburg, Germany and to parts of Denmark.

Next season contains, except for concerts in Denmark, of a longer trip to Spain. The year 2005 is official H.C. Andersen year which we will celebrate by building a bridge between his literature and our music.

The object of Copenhagen Brass is to entertain in traditional contexts, but we are also interested in playing in more extraordinary environments, in order to give as wide an audience as possible, the opportunity to get acquainted to brass music.



The conductor

Professor at the Royal Danish Conservatory of Music, Mogens Andresen, is wide acclaimed in music circles. He is the most active Danish arranger of brass music and is also responsible for several new compositions for brass. In 1977 Mogens Andresen founded Royal Danish Brass consisting of musicians from the Royal Danish Orchestra, which since has inspired and encouraged the brass music culture in Denmark.
